

## Nonprofits we'll be serving:

**Habitat for Humanity** brings people together to build homes, communities and hope.

**The Hurricane Island Foundation** integrates science education, applied research, and leadership development through year-round educational programs and a seasonal, environmentally-sustainable island community.

**Knox County Homeless Coalition** offers a comprehensive approach to helping people get back to productive and self-sustaining lives. They provide different forms of shelter and wraparound care —whenever they are needed.

**Loaves & Fishes** weekend lunch program at St. Peter's Episcopal church in Rockland offers a midday meal on weekends to anyone who needs it.

**Maine Coast Heritage Trust** works in all seven coastal counties to protect land, care for the land, connect you to the coast, and support other Maine land trusts.

**Mid-Coast Recovery Coalition** was created to support individuals and families to find help and healing for addiction.

**P.A.W.S.** provides a safe, caring environment for homeless and abandoned dogs and cats until they can be placed with loving families, and promotes humane values in our communities.

**Pope Memorial Humane Society** of Knox County cares for and places unwanted and abandoned animals in loving homes; promotes responsible pet ownership & humane treatment of all animals; and works to end pet overpopulation through spay/neuter programs.

**Waldo Theatre, Inc.** is working to restore the historic Waldo Theatre in Waldoboro. They envision a space for live theatre, programming for children, live music, educational panels, and a community gathering place.

**Youthlinks** programs create positive experiences that inspire and empower youth. Out-of-school programs connect young people with the local community while developing healthy life skills, and committing to a safe place — a place where they belong.




